Snape Emergency Plan How to prepare for emergencies

So that you are prepared for emergencies, you may find it useful to put together the following essential items:

- Copies of your home insurance documents.
- A torch with spare batteries.
- A wind-up or battery radio.
- A corded telephone *
- Warm, waterproof clothing and blankets.
- A first-aid kit and prescription medication.
- Bottled water and non-perishable foods.
- Baby food and baby care items.
- A list of important contact numbers.

^{*} Telephones: Modern cordless telephones with a base station and carryaround handsets do not work without mains power. If your telephone or its base station are plugged into the mains, consider buying a corded phone for your emergency kit. This will be powered by the low voltage from the BT socket and will normally work during power outages.
