Wild strawberries were everywhere and we made the exciting discovery of 14 bee orchids. We have since spotted four pyramidal orchids too. Please do visit the wood - it's a real jewel in our village. A special thank you to our member Richard Featherstone for renovating the picnic table and signs.

Mike Wade & Judy Powell (woodland experts) came to advise us on 19 June. They identified existing trees & plants & suggested ways forward for managing the wood, such as coppicing, removal of overcrowded trees etc. They were very impressed by the wood and will attend our next work party.

Snape Marshes—Lesley & Derek Walduck led an orchid walk on 10 June, with 12 attendees. There were thousands of Southern Marsh Orchids, meadow buttercup, watermint, & yellow rattle. Everyone finished up in the Golden Key and didn't seem to want to go home!
