- The cost of this booking will be £ .00. An invoice will be sent at the start of the month following all events.
  - A combined booking/damage deposit of £100 is required for private parties, weddings and commercial events, payable at the time of booking. Should the event then be cancelled, £30.00 will be withheld as a cancellation charge. If there is no damage and the Hall is cleaned satisfactorily, the whole charge will be refunded.
- Cheques are to be made payable to "Snape Village Hall".
- For regular hirers, should you cancel a booking, notice is required 48 hours before the start of the event, by contacting the Booking Secretary, otherwise you will be charged for the hire.
  - You can collect the key from the key-safe, to the right of the main entrance doors.
- The code will be available from the Booking Secretary 24 hours prior to the event.
- No Blu Tack / sticky tape / pins on walls or painted surfaces, and no candles in the Hall
  - Hirers must at the start of each event/meeting point out all fire exits in the Hall.
  - Those groups working with children and vulnerable adults will require their own up-to-date safeguarding policies.
  - Please ensure the Hall is left clean and tidy, and that the floor is hoovered or swept, and all crockery and cutlery is washed and put away after your event. The heating and lights must be switched off before you leave.
  - Reasonable clearing up time is not charged for, unless it prevents the VHMC from taking another booking, when we reserve the right to apply a charge of £50 to cover any lost income and additional management costs.
