ROAD CLOSURES A rolling road closure will be enforced throughout the day. This means roads on and around the race route will be closed for the short period in which it takes the race to pass by - usually about 10 to 15 minutes around the estimated time of arrival and indicated by police escort vehicles. The route is marked with yellow advanced warning signs in the run up to the race. Please look out for these for more information.



NO PARKING Areas where parking is restricted are lined with yellow "no waiting" cones in the week leading up to the race. Please don't park on the route on race day, if necessary vehicles may be removed.

Please also note: parking in the start and finish towns will be restricted from the night before.



POLICE The race is escorted along the route by trained police officers and escort motorcyclists. If you are asked to stop by an officer, please listen carefully and obey their instructions.



LISTEN There will be an advance vehicle 15 minutes ahead of the race, keeping you up-todate with what is happening, including when you can expect the race to pass through.



**CAUTION** Please stay back from the edge of the road and keep animals on a lead, away from the roadside. Riders pass by very fast, while we encourage support, please keep flags, objects and photography equipment out of the road. Remember, taking selfies is fun, but turning your back on the race is never a good idea. Please face the oncoming riders and race convoy at all times.
