Annual Report for Snape Playing Field

Year end 30th April 2023

The original Trust Deed of The Snape Playing Field Charity, dated 14th January 2010, states the geographical area of benefit (Dunningworth Hall & 2 kilometre radius area north of Snape Bridge), and lays out the objects, powers, constitution and official functions of the committee

Currently 8 trustees make up the committee: - TB, EG, (MW), MT, MN, DN, PB, RB

The official number of trustees should be 9, with 3 appointed members from the PC and 1 from the BL. The remaining 5 members are elected. This may include 2 co-opted members.

The Trust Deed has never been updated. Should we review the trust deed in conjunction with the Charity Commission requirements? Would reference to the Village Hall Committee help as much the same status?

Thanks to committee members for work in the last year. Now MT standing down as treasurer we need to appoint someone else. MT happy to stay on committee, so perhaps one more member needed.

Thank you to the Parish Council for continuing to fund grass cutting and hedge cutting.
